ORDINANCE 23 (Amended June 9, 2025)

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

Section I - Intent - The Town of Dellona, Sauk County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle requirements for the operation of all-terrain vehicles within the Town of Dellona.

Section II - Statutory Authority - These route(s) are created pursuant to authority granted to the Town of Dellona under 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

Section III. - Adoption of 22.33 Wis. Stats. - All applicable provisions of 23.33 Wis. Stats. Regulating ATV operations and ATV routes are adopted herewith.

Section IV - Routes - The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Dellona may, from time to time, amend this ordinance to modify operating limitations and conditions and to add, delete, or modify authorized routes. All Dellona Town Roads are currently authorized for ATV use as well as the Transition Route on Highway 23 between Turtle Road and Dellwood Road

Section V - Conditions - As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. ATV operators shall observe the lower of the posted roadway speed or 45 mph.
- B. All ATV operators shall ride a single file.
- C. Routes sign, where posted, must comply with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)c.
- D. Operations on designated routes are only permitted between the hours 6:00 am and 10:00 pm..

Section VI- Enforcement - This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin.

Section VII - Penalties - Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VIII - Severability - The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be deemed affected.
